WHAT IS PARENT PATHWAYS?

Parent Pathways is a voluntary service designed to help you set and reach your future goals. It's flexible, accessible, and tailored to your unique situation.

You'll work with a mentor who will support you throughout your time in Parent Pathways.

You'll receive tailored advice, guidance and resources in a supportive and safe environment, where your children are always welcome.

Eligibility

- Has care of a child under 6 years of age
- Isn't in paid employment

You must also be receiving:

- Parenting Payment
- Carer Payment
- Special Benefit


You're also eligible if you're not getting a Centrelink payment, & are either:

- Under 22 years of age
- An early school leaver (parents who don't have a Year 12 qualification)
- A First Nations parent or carer

By Discussing how you can source financial assistance
